

## Unit 2: Animals



Lindy Loo introduces children to the wonderful world of animals through the digital story, "A Pet for Lindy Loo." This rhyming story sees Lindy Loo trying to decide the best pet for herself. Concepts of big and small, animal habitats and appearance, and mothers and babies are introduced through a series of entertaining interactive learning objects.

### Objectives

- To identify animals that live in the jungle, on the farm and in the sea.
- To identify names of these animals.
- To identify and name baby animals.
- To recognise the difference between big and small animals.
- To identify sounds animals make and the words used to describe these sounds.
- To develop written and spoken vocabulary of words associated with animals
